


## Last week in North America

Air travel demand in the US last week was between 80% and 85% of the level seen in 2019, a slight improvement on the previous week. Meanwhile, air travel demand in Canada which had fallen away alarmingly since the end of the New Year holiday period, finally showed signs of picking up again as demand was between 35% and 40% of the same period in 2019.

Only two new routes launched in the region last week, both operated by United, one each from its Newark and Houston hubs. Texarkana Regional Airport, as the name rather implies, is close to the border between Texas and Arkansas. Apart from United's new service to Houston, the airport's only other schedule service is currently with American to Dallas/Fort Worth. The airport recently started work on a new terminal.
