


## Last week in Europe

24 July 2022 - 30 July 2022

Between Sunday 24 July and Saturday 30 July, Air Service One has identified:

- 20 new routes involving at least one European airport, operated by eight airlines involving 29 airports.
- Iberia launched the most new routes with seven. Then came Turkish Airlines with four and Flybe with three.
- 8 (40%) were already served by other carriers, 12 (60%) were not
- 10 countries involved including two non-European (Morocco and Oman).
- Average weekly frequency of new services: 2.55 (last week: 1.53)
- Average sector length of new services: 1,415km (last week: 2,426km).
  This week, the longest new route was Royal Air Maroc's Casablanca to Bodrum service at 3,215km. Iberia's Alicante to Nador and Flybe's Birmingham to Edinburgh were the shortest at 402km.
- Airports in Spain welcomed the most, new services, with 11, followed by Germany and Turkey with seven each and UK with five.
- Among airports it was a tie for most new services with Santander and Stuttgart both registering three.
